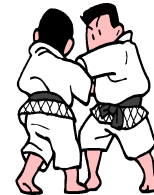

Must have current USJA, USA Judo or USJF card. Applications available at the tournament site.
BRING YOUR MEMBERSHIP CARD TO VERIFY ELIGIBILITY.

Match Time:

Junior matches: 5-16 yrs. old – 3 minutes; 17-20 yrs. old – 5 minutes, **Senior** matches: 5 minutes,
Master Men and Women matches: 4 minutes

Scoring:

Double elimination system

Awards:

1st place trophy for Senior team with most points. 1st place trophy for Junior team with most points.
Also, 1st 2nd and 3rd individual awards.

Entry Fees:

\$40.00 by mail must be postmarked by October 27, 2018. \$50.00 at tournament door (\$20.00 second division). Make money order/cashier checks payable to Dave V. Melton Sr.

Divisions:

Junior boys and girls – 5-6 yrs. old, 7-8 yrs. old, 9-10 yrs. old, 11-12 yrs. old, 13-14 yrs. old, 15-16 yrs. old, light, medium, and heavy. Please make note **Junior girls**: divisions are subject to change due to safety and number of entries. **Senior Women**: light, medium, and heavy: divisions are subject to change due to safety and number of entries. **Senior Men**: 132, 145, 161, 178, 198, 220 and over 220.
Master Men: 30-39, 40-49, 50-59, 60+, light, middle, and heavy, if we have enough for a match.
Master Women: 30-39, 40-49, 50-59, 60+, light, middle, and heavy, if we have enough for a match.

Rules:

Current IJF rules will be used with the following modifications: Shime-waze (chokes) not allowed for juniors 12 years old and under, kansetu waze (arm locks) no arm locks for 16 and under and under the rank of sankyu. No flying scissors in any division. Juniors 14, 15 and 16 yrs. of age will be allowed to compete in senior competition under senior competition rules **PROVIDED PARENT AND COACH SO NOTE ON RELEASE FORM AND SIGN THE FORM.** The CARE system will not be used. There will be 3 referees on the mat. Contest area will be 6 meters. The safety and out of bounds area will have 4 meters to adjoining contest areas and 3 meters everywhere else.
