Hosting a Local Judo Event

To develop and sustain the local judo community, events need to occur. The Shufu executive committee is seeking hosts for events.

What does it take to host an event?

- Ensure USJF sanction event requirements are met (venue, mats, safety criteria for insurance). Draft and submit a USJF sanction request through Shufu
- Reach agreement with Shufu on roles and responsibilities
- Collect and categorize / bracket pre-registration
- Collect registration or use online registration service (Shufu or other)
- Identify and coordinate responsibilities for lead referee, lead kata judge, technical officials, officials' food, as needed
- Handle registration, check-in, bracketing, etc. as needed
- Prepare post-event records and reports: financial summary report and summary of event report
- Submit final event summary report to Shufu to be forwarded to USJF
