Transportation and Logistics

From the north: From the Capital Beltway (Interstate 495) traveling south, take Exit 54B, Braddock Road (Route 620 West) to end of exit ramp. Go straight across Braddock Rd. to Port Royal Road.

From the south: From the Capital Beltway (Interstate 495) traveling north, take Exit 54A, Braddock Road (Route 620 West). Go 0.3 miles on Braddock Road, turn left onto Port Royal Road.

From Braddock Road, go south on Port Royal for 0.6 miles. Sport Judo is on the left. There is onsite parking without fee.

Fees & Payments

- Registration Fee: \$ 50
- Black Belts only:
 - USJF Promotional Fees: \$125 for Shodan plus \$25 for each rank step above Shodan, plus an additional \$25 for Shichidan and Hachidan. (Payable to USJF. Check will be returned if you are not promoted.)
 - Life Members: \$0.
 - Shufu Promotion Fee: \$15 (Check payable to Shufu Judo Yudanshakai)

Event fees can be paid online by credit card. Checks and cash accepted on the day of the event. Cash must be exact amount. Credit Card processing is not available on the day of the event.

Waivers

Waivers will be signed on the morning of the event.

Accommodations

If you require an accommodation for visual or hearing impairment or other reason, please let us know on the registration form.

Food:

There is no concession onsite at Sport Judo. There are a number of facilities for food at the intersection of Braddock Road and Port Royal Road.

Eligibility for Promotion

All judoka must be a current member of the USJF, USJA, or USA Judo. Judoka must present their membership card at the time of event check-in. There will be the opportunity to register with the USJF at the event site.

This event is open to all registered judoka from the three national judo organizations noted above. However, only members of the USJF are eligible for promotion at this event. USA Judo and USJA members may request to be examined and have their results from their participation forwarded to the appropriate organization for consideration.

Rank Requirements

Examinees must be recommended for promotion by their instructor and meet established Shufu Judo Yudanshakai promotional requirements. Examinees are expected to have met the following requirements for higher rank before examination:

- Time in grade
- Required accumulated promotional points(documentation submitted)
- Any kata examination requirement should be completed before the day of the Shufu Promotion.

Note: The Shufu Board of Examiners has delayed the changeover to the USJF promotional requirements until the USJF has clarified those standards. The 2019 Shufu Fall Promotional will follow the (unchanged) Shufu Promotional Requirements, available at [Shufu Promotions](#).

Documentation required

Examinees should be listed on the [JUDOKA RECOMMENDED FOR PROMOTION](#) form that is submitted by the head instructor from each club.

All judoka seeking rank as a current competitor must submit proper documentation of competition results (copy of official record book signed for each event).

Kata score sheets must be graded by a member of the Shufu Board of Examiners.

Certification to Instructor, Referee, or Technical (as required by the rank sought).

Any judoka being evaluated for a Dan (Black Belt) rank are required to submit the following documentation electronically:

(See Shufu website under "[Promotion](#)" for how to submit each document.)

- A completed, *editable* Form 20.
- Promotion Registration fee of \$50. (Additional fees, as required, to Shufu and to USJF to be paid at the event.)
- [USJF background check](#) (for judoka 18 years of age and older)
- Dan rank promotions above Shodan require current membership in USJF plus three years prior membership; for Shodan, current membership in USJF plus one year prior membership.
- Promotion certificate for current rank
- Safe Sport and [Heads Up](#) certifications (only if applying for Shodan)
- Kata Scores (as required by the rank sought)
- Certificates (as required by the rank sought)

Due Dates:

- ***The Form 20 must be sent to the Rank Registration Chair by Friday, March 8, 2019*** to be considered by the Shufu Board of Examiners at the April 2019 promotional. Send the form to Karen Whilden, Rank Registration Chair, at shufurankreg@gmail.com
- The Rank Registration Chair will then work with the candidate to identify and cure any problems with the Form 20, with that process to be completed at least 14 days before the promotional. ***If a Form 20 has not been submitted by Friday, March 8, 2019, and revised as needed by Sunday, March 24, 2019, the Shufu Board of Examiners will table the promotion request until the next promotional.*** By this means, we can greatly increase Shufu's ability to get Dan promotions accepted by USJF and ranks recognized more quickly than they are now.
- March 24, 2019 will be the last day to submit any documentation to the Rank Registration Chair.

Shufu Board of Directors

This meeting is for current members of Shufu Judo Yudanshakai who hold the current rank of Shodan (1st Degree Black Belt) or higher.
